- 2) Pray for the persecuted church throughout the world In the Central African Republic, almost five years after being forced to abandon their home, a pastor and his family are still unable to return. Pastor Pamphile, who had served in the capital city of Bangui since 1990, was forced to flee with his family after angry Muslims began to intimidate his congregation and disrupt services. They wanted to build a mosque nearby but didn't want it next to a church. In 2013, a group of Muslims armed with machetes surrounded the pastor's house, and he could hear them discussing whether to kill him or just destroy the church. After the group left, he and his family grabbed what they could and fled. Days later, he learned that both his house

and the church had been destroyed. Muslims have since driven out the entire Christian community.
