- 2) Pray for the persecuted church throughout the world: **In Bangladesh** – A Christian convert from Islam, imprisoned for more than two years, was released on bail recently. Sisir Islam became a believer in 2012 and immediately began sharing Jesus with others in his community, leading 17 friends to Christ. On Sept. 23, 2014, after returning home from a Bible training center, he was charged with the murder of a local business man. Muslim leaders had accused him of the murder as retribution for his conversion to Christianity. He was treated poorly in prison and was frequently ill. In July 2018, he was released on bail and returned home to recover. Pray for his faithful witness, and full recovery.
