Then, after her family learned that Adamu had helped her, they came after him one evening while he was visiting his uncle. The woman's family members and some villagers beat Adamu and a friend so badly that they lost consciousness. Adamu has since undergone numerous surgeries, and his injuries prevent him from talking.
