#### FAITH FOCUS ON PRAYER (“pray without ceasing...” - I Thess. 5:17):

- 1) To keep our words and thoughts acceptable in the Lord's sight
- 2) Pray for the persecuted church in Mali – On Sunday evening, June 9, Muslim militants fired shots and set fire to a central Mali village. The attack killed an estimated 95 people, including men, women and children—a third of the village. A contact on the ground in Mali confirmed that all those who died were Christians. A survivor of the attacks told a news agency: “About 50 heavily armed men arrived on motorbikes and pickups. They surrounded the village and then attacked—anyone who tried to escape was killed. No one was spared—women, children, elderly people.” Many of the bodies were found burned. Continue to pray with Christians in this West African region (which includes Mali, Burkina Faso, Chad and Niger). Pray that God's love and calming presence would be experienced and that His grace and mercy would be at work through this violence.
- 3) For revival in our nation and New York state, and for believers to be salt and light
- 4) For the first responders of our community
- 5) George Glasow - back home from hospital - enjoys visitors
- 6) Jim Todd - encouragement
- 7) Laura Miller - neuromuscular disease
- 8) Elyse's dad (Warren Howard) - ongoing medical needs
- 9) Sharon Kinney's sister, Katie - physical & spiritual needs
