The pastor, who has been detained since his arrest in March 2017, allegedly crossed the China-Myanmar border to minister to 2,000 impoverished minority children in Myanmar's northern Wa state. He also helped build 16 schools there after building more than a dozen schools in China. Pray for the pastor's wife, who is an American citizen, and their two sons. His arrest and sentencing are likely related to the Communist Party's attempts to control the house church movement.
